Cookies

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that is downloaded onto 'terminal equipment' (eg a computer or smartphone) when the user accesses a website. It allows the website to recognise that user's device and store some information about the user's preferences or past actions.

A session cookie (also called a transient cookie) is a cookie that is erased when the user closes the Web browser. The session cookie is stored in temporary memory and is not retained after the browser is closed. Session cookies do not collect information from the users computer. They typically will store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.

A persistent cookie (also called a permanent cookie or a stored cookie) is a cookie that is stored on a users hard drive until it expires (persistent cookies are set with expiration dates) or until the user deletes the cookie. Persistent cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as Web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific Web site.

The Hull Magicians' Circle ticket website uses cookies to remember the tickets a user wishes to buy when they add them to their online basket and proceed to the checkout. These cookies are not identifiable to an individual and are not shared to third parties.
